## **Defence**

- 1. 2nd Indo Oman Joint Army Exercise Al Nagah Ii 2017 held in Himachal Pradesh.
- 2. India Navy commissioned *INS Tillanchang* as third ship of 4 Water Jet Fast Attack Crafts built by Kolkata based Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE). First two ships INS Tarmugli and INS Tihayu which were commissioned in 2016.
- 3. Indian Air force launched ebilling system *Aviation Turbine Fuel Digital Issue and Payment (ATF DIP)*, for speedy accounting and clearance of Aviation Fuel bills of Oil Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs).
- 4. Indian Navy commissioned surveillance ship INLCU L51, as first of 8 ships of LCU Mk IV Class.
- 5. Indian Navy deinducted TU142M Long Range Maritime Patrol aircraft after 29 years of service (30,000 hours of flying).

- 6. Indian Navy successfully conducted first test of short range surfacetoair Barak missile (Developed jointly by India and Israel) from aircraft carrier INS Vikramaditya.
- 7. Indian Navy unveiled Integrated Automatic Aviation Meteorological System (IAAMS) at Rajali Air Station in Tamil Nadu, to modernise meteorological infrastructure of the 9 Naval Air Stations (NAS) to bring accuracy in weather monitoring.
- 8. Indian Navy's Aircraft Carrier INS Viraat has been decommissioned. It is world's oldest and longest serving Aircraft carrier with 30 years' service in Indian Navy and 27 years in Royal Navy.
- 9. Indo Nepal Joint Military Exercise Surya Kiran XI held at Pithoragarh (Uttarakhand).
- 10. Landattack version of BrahMos supersonic cruise missile with extended range increased from 290 km to 450 km has been successfully test fired.
- BrahMos Aerospace is a joint venture of India and Russia. It has top supersonic speed of Mach 2.
- Its earlier strike range was 290 km. But after India's induction into the Missile Technology Control Regime (MTCR) in June 2016, missile's range has been increased beyond 300km in same configuration.
- 11. Ninth Gorkha Rifles celebrated 200years of its raising in Secunderabad (Telangana). First battalion of the Ninth Gorkhas was raised by the British government in 1817 as 'Fatehgarh Levy'.
- 12. Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) signed MoU with National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and National Skill Development Fund (NSDF) for skill development of its serving/retired personnel and their family members.
- 13. Tanushree Pareek from Rajasthan became first woman field officer in Border Security Force (BSF).

## **Economy**

- 1. Airline Jet Airways announced partnership with cab aggregator Uber to book airport cabs through Jet Airways app.
- 2. Airtel acquired 4G business of Tikona Networks including Broadband Wireless Access (BWA) business for 1600 crores. Now Airtel will be second company after Reliance Jio to have pan India presence in 2300 Mhz band.
- 3. Asian Development Bank (ADB) signed \$350 million loan with India for improving 1,500 kilometers of major district roads in Madhya Pradesh.
- 4. Bandhan Bank signed agreement with payment solution provider Avenues India Pvt Ltd, to improve customer service.
- 5. Bengaluru based Vijaya Bank opened it's 2000th Branch in Tirupati (Andhra Pradesh).
- 6. Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) approved Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IndianOil) to sell its 24 % equity in Lubrizol India Private Limited (LIPL) to Lubrizol Corporation, USA.
- 7. Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) approved Policy for Early Monetization of Coal Bed Methane (*Methane obtained from Coal Mines*) Gas Marketing and Pricing Freedom for CBM Gas. It provides marketing and pricing freedom to CBM Contractors to sell CBM at Arm's Length Price in domestic market.
- 8. Cabinet approved 4 GST Bills, to step up towards implementing GST from July 1, 2017. Bills are
- Central GST It provides for levy and collection of tax on intrastate supply of goods / services by Central Government.
- iGST It makes provisions for levy and collection of tax on interstate supply of goods / services by Central Government.
- UTGST Similar to States Goods and Services Tax (SGST) which shall be levied and collected by States/Union Territories on intrastatsupply of goods / services.
- Compensation Bill It provides for compensation to the states for loss of revenue arising due to implementation of goods and services tax for 5 years as per section 18 of Constitution (One Hundred and First Amendment) Act 2016.
- Additionally, central government has been empowered to impose additional tax of up to 1 % on interstate supply of goods for 2 years.
- 9. Canara, HSBC and Oriental Bank of Commerce Life Insurance launched *iSelect* term plan to expand its online product suit with family protection, providing enhanced protection cover for family at an affordable premium.
- 10. Commerce and Industry Minister Nirmala Sitharaman launched TIES (Trade Infrastructure for Export Scheme), for developing export linked infrastructure in states to promote exports.
- A Committee for sanctioning and monitoring of the project will be set up, to be headed by commerce secretary (Rita Teaotia currently).
- Beneficiaries All central and state agencies including Commodities Boards, Export Promotion Councils, SEZ authorities and Apex Trade Bodies recognised under EXIM policy of Central Government are eligible for financial support.
- Funding Cost of projects will be equally shared by Centre and states. Centre will borne 50% of total equity in project, except in case of projects in northeastern and Himalayan states, where Centre may bear 80% of cost.
- 11. Competition Commission of India (CCI) approved demerger of Reliance Communications wireless division into *Aircel* and Dishnet Wireless Ltd.
- 12. Completely Government owned Housing and Urban Development Corp (HUDCO) received Securities and Exchange Board of India's (SEBI) approval to raise funds through an IPO (Initial Public Offering).

- 13. Ecommerce firm Amazon India launched new program for sellers to get insights and help related to goods and services tax *AZ GST Guide*. It provides resources in the form of tutorials, blogs, and free online training sessions.
- 14. ESAF Microfinance Company issued Commercial Papers (CP) worth Rs 330 crore, that can be subscribed by Private Sector Banks and NBFCs. ESAF Microfinance is also the first company from Kerala to open a Small Finance Bank recently.
- 15. Facebook launched She Leads Tech programme to mentor startups founded by women by giving them access to yearlong program that provides tools and resources.

- 54. First Regional Conference of Eastern States on enhancing steel consumption in India was held in Gangtok (Sikkim) with theme *Enhancing steel consumption in India*.
- 55. First fully Indiamade train Medha flagged off at Dadar station in Mumbai.
- 56. First smart tribal model village 'Hubbi' inaugurated at Rajouri district of Jammu and Kashmir.
- 57. Five Indians named in 2017 World Economic Forum's 100 Young Global Leaders (Under 40) list Vijay Shekhar Sharma (Paytm Founder), Shruti Shibulal (Tamara Hospitality), Ambarish Mitra (Founder of Blippar), Hindol Sengupta and Rwitwika Bhattacharya Agarwal.
- 58. Focussing on women and new born welfare, Telangana CM K Chandrasekhar Rao launched KCR Kit scheme, at approx. budget of 605 crores. It consists of 16 essentials for a newborn and will be useful for up to three months.
- 59. Food Safety and Standard Authority of India (FSSAI) and Coca Cola India signed MoU to train 50,000 street food vendors over 3 years, as part of FSSAI's *Clean Street Food* initiative.
- 60. Footwear Design and Development Institute (FDDI) Bill 2017 Introduced in Lok Sabha, .aimed at declaring FDDI as an Institution of National Importance (INI).
- 61. For the first time in India, four states Odisha, West Bengal, Chhattisgarh and Jharkhand will conduct a synchronized elephant census in May 2017.
- Number of elephants in these states In 2015 Odisha 1,954, Jharkhand 700, Chhattisgarh 275, West Bengal 130.
- 62. GRAPES3 experiment at TIFR's (Tata Institute of Fundamental Research) Cosmic Ray Laboratory in Ooty (Tamil Nadu) has been upgraded to detect solar storms.
- 63. Global Food Fair *World Food India 2017* will be held by Ministry of Food Processing Industries in November 2017 at New Delhi.
- 64. Google and Telangana Government signed MoU to boost digitisation efforts of state government.
- 65. Government approved Introduction of Indian Institutes of Information Technology Public Private Partnership (IIIT PPP) Bill 2017, To declare 15 Indian Institutes of Information Technology as Institutions of National Importance. It will enable IITs to grant degrees to their students.
- 66. Government approved construction of 117,814 more affordable houses for urban poor under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) in six states (Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand and Odisha) with investment of 5,773 crore. With this, total affordable homes sanctioned under PMAY came up to to 1,760,507 with investment of 96,018 crores.
- 67. Government approved enhancing 4000 Post Graduate seats in medical colleges and hospitals across country, taking total number of PG seats available in country up to over 35000.

- 68. Government approved sale of Steel Authority of India Limited's (SAIL) 3 special steel plants Alloy Steels Plant located at Durgapur (West Bengal), Salem Steel Plant (Tamil Nadu) and Visvesvaraya Iron and Steel Plant (Bhadravati, Karnataka). Approx 15,000 crore rupees are expect to be raised from this disinvestment.
- 69. Government approved setting up National Commission for Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (NSEBC) as a constitutional body, by insertion of Article 338B through a constitutional amendment.
- 70. Government extended time period for elementary school teachers for acquiring essential qualification by March 2019, as against earlier March 2015. It has been done with an amendment in Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act 2009, that envisages free and compulsory elementary education to every child in age group of 614 years.
- 71. Government has set up target to increase nuclear power generation capacity to 15,000 MW by 2024, up from 5000 MW Currently.
- 72. Government imposed 10% import duty on wheat and tur dal to protect farmers' interest amid projection of a record crop this year.
- 73. Government launched Online Vigilance Clearance System and eService Book in New Delhi, aiming to fast track process of cases of vigilance clearance for senior level appointments in central government.
- 74. Government launched first across the river survey in River Ganga to determine population of aquatic life, including endangered Gangetic doplhin.
- 75. Government of Andhra Pradesh proposed deploying a Smart Mosquito Density System. Under this, modern technologies will be deployed to detect mosquito breeding before malaria and other vector borne diseases such as dengue, chikungunya and zika become an epidemic.
- 76. Government released commemorative postage stamp on occasion of 100th anniversary of Yogoda Satsanga Society of India.
- 77. Government stated Animal Welfare Board of India (under Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change) will now be permanently chaired by a senior MoEF official.
- 78. Government will change 4 decade old definition of blindness to bring it in line with World Health Organisation (WHO) criteria and ensure Indian data on blindness meets the global estimates. As per National Programme for Control of Blindness (NPCB), in India person is blind if he is unable to count fingers from a distance of 6 metres, while WHO stipulates this distance as 3 metres.
- 79. Government will launch India's first of its kind Indian Sign Language (ISL) dictionary, aim in to bring uniformity in sign languages used by hearing and speech impaired people. It is being developed by Indian Sign Language Research and Training Centre (ISLRTC).
- 80. Government's biotech innovation BIRAC Regional Entrepreneurship Centre set up in Bengaluru, in Centre for Cellular and Molecular Platforms CCAMP. Center will encourage spirit of bio-entrepreneurship.
- 81. Gujarat Assembly passed Gujarat Animal Preservation (Amendment) Bill 2017 to amend Gujarat Animal Preservation Act 1954. This amendment has made parent act much more strict and provisions harsher punishment to prevent cow slaughter in state.
- 82. Gujarat based Aashray Promotion of Social Enterprises Foundation signed MoU with Jharkhand government to establish an incubation center for startups in state.
- 83. Gujarat government signed agreement with cloud based solutions provider cloudBuy.com to develop B2B marketplace for small and large business units in state.
- 84. Haryana Government announced Tirtha Darshan Scheme under which senior citizens above 60 years of age in the state will be able to go on a pilgrimage within country at government expense.
- 85. Health Minister J P Nadda launched National Health Policy 2017 with an aim to provide healthcare in an assured manner to all, particularly to the undeserved and underprivileged.
- Policy proposes raising public health expenditure to 2.5 % of GDP.
- It seeks to increase life expectancy at birth from 67.5 to 70 by 2025 and reduce infant mortality rate to 28 by 2019.
- It also seeks to achieve and maintain elimination status of Leprosy by 2018.
- It seeks to establish tracking of disability adjusted life years (DALY) Index as a measure of burden of disease and its major categories trends by 2022.
- 86. Himachal Pradesh Government launched mobile App and website *Mera Hunar* HP for jobseekers, to enable skilled persons to apply for various jobs as per their convenience and eligibility.
- 87. Hindustan Aeronautics Limited announced to deliver 123 Tejas aircrafts to Indian Air Force (IAF) by 2024.
- 88. Human Resource Development Ministry made it mandatory for students to have Aadhaar card to get served cooked meal under Mid-Day Meal (MDM) Scheme.

- 89. India to host its first mobile world congress in delhi in September 2017, with special focus on reaching out to South East Asian markets.
- 90. India will host its first mobile congress in September 2017 in New Delhi.
- 91. India's contribution to United Nations rose 55% to Rs 244 crore in 201516 compared with previous year.
- 92. Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) and International Crops Research Institute for the Semi-Arid Tropics (ICRISAT) signed agreement to work together on crop improvement and agronomy programmes for grain legumes and dryland cereals.
- 93. Indian Institute of Technology Kharagpur becomes first academic institution to get a supercomputing facility under National Supercomputing Mission (NSM).
- 94. Indian Institute of Technology, Madras (IITM) and Indian Army signed MoU to identify critical technological areas that can be enhanced in the armed forces.
- 95. India's first vertical garden set up at Hosur Road Electronics City Flyover in Bengaluru (Karnataka), by NGO SayTrees, to protect nature.
- 96. India's longest surface tunnel in Jammu and Kashmir's Udhampur district will be opened to soon. 9kmlong tunnel at Chenani passes through the lower Himalayan mountain range on Jammu Srinagar National Highway and reduces travel distance between Jammu and Srinagar by 30 kilometres (time saveing of 3 4 hours).
- 97. Information and Broadcasting Ministry launched *eCinepramaan* as online film certification system of Central Board of Film Certification (CBFC), to automate film certification process and make it transparent and efficient.
- 98. International conference on VISION ZERO and its relevance to Occupational Safety and Health (OSH), held in New Delhi.
- 99. Kanha Tiger Reserve in Madhya Pradesh became first tiger reserve in India to officially introduce a mascot named Bhoorsingh the Barasingha.
- 100. Karnataka CM Siddaramaiah launched online platform Pratibimba to showcase government's achievements.
- 101. Karnataka Government announced Idea2POC (Proof of Concept) fund of 10 crore for women entrepreneurs. Under this, Karnataka Government will fund up to 50 lakh for any woman innovator looking for funds for Proof of Concept validation, certification, and cover costs in manufacturing of pilot devices.
- 102. Law Commission of India (LCI) in its 267th Report has laid out dangers of hate speech and called Union Government for action.
- 103. Lok Sabha approved winding up 8 tribunals
- Competition Appellate Tribunal, Airports Economic Regulatory Authority Appellate Tribunal (AERAAT), Cyber Appellate Tribunal, EPF Appellate Tribunal, Cases under the Foreign Exchange Management Act of 1999, National Highways Tribunal, Railways Rates Tribunal and Copyright Board.
- 104. Lok Sabha passed Admiralty (Jurisdiction and Settlement of Maritime Claims) Bill 2016, aimed at establishing uniform legal framework by consolidating existing laws relating to admiralty jurisdiction of courts, admiralty proceedings on maritime claims, arrest of vessels etc. Laws to be omitted are Admiralty Court Acts of 1840 & 1861, Colonial Courts of Admiralty Acts of 1890 & 1891, Provisions of Letters Patent 1865.
- 105. Maharashtra Institute of Technology (MIT) Pune and IBM developed robot *Chintu* to assist senior citizens in their everyday tasks.
- 106. Maharashtra government will implement Maharashtra City Taxi Regulations 2017, to regulate web based taxi services in state. Under new regulation, service provider will have to register in city to operate the taxi service and fares will be regulated by government.
- 107. Manipur High Court declared 4 month long economic blockade called by United Naga Council (UNC) as illegal. UNC had blocked key national highways (number 2 and 37) connecting Manipur with rest of northeast region since November 2016, protesting against creation of seven new districts in state.
- 108. Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Radha Mohan Singh inaugurated new Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK) in Tripura.
- 109. Minister of Communications Manoj Sinha released Postage Stamp on cub scouts to commemorate Centenary year of Cub Scouts in India and abroad.
- 110. Ministry of Agriculture launched *Mission Fingerling,* to enable development of fisheries sector in India with expenditure of 520 crores. It aims at achieving fisheries production from 10.79 mmt (201415) to 15 mmt by 202021 under Blue Revolution.
- Government will also launch program on ornamental fisheries in 8 potential States (cost of 61 crores) Assam, West Bengal, Odisha, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and Kerala.
- 111. Ministry of Environment provided 6 months window to industrial projects functioning without environmental clearance (EC) to apply for a backdated EC.

- 113. Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change (MoEFCC) launched Stage II of HCFCs Phase Out Management Plan (HPMP) for 201723 period. It aims to phase out use of Hydro chloro-fluorocarbons (HCFCs), harmful ozone depleting substances (ODS) by switching over to non-ozone depleting and low global warming potential technologies.
- 114. Ministry of Food Processing Industries (FPI) sanctioned 101 new integrated cold chain projects, at investment of 3,100 crores. Maharashtra has maximum (21) of projects, followed by Uttar Pradesh (14) and Gujarat (12).
- 115. Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas has announced new Open Acreage Licensing Policy (OALP) for oil and gas exploration, aiming to attract greater foreign investment to boost output by allowing bidders to carve out areas where they want to drill.
- OALP provides operational flexibility to the investors by offering single license to explore conventional and unconventional oil and gas resources. Currently, government identifies oil and gas blocks and then puts them on auction.
- Government will now conduct auction of oil and gas blocks twice a year, with the first round being held in July 2017.
- Selection of oil blocks will be based on data by Directorate General of Hydrocarbons in National Data Repository which offers total 160TB data of India's 26 sedimentary basins.
- 116. Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas launched *MoPNG eSeva* grievance redressal platform regarding petroleum and gas sector.
- 117. Ministry of Road Transport and Highways launched 2 echallan and mparivahan mobile applications to provide digital solution for enforcement of traffic rules. These applications will provide access to various services and will enable citizens to report any traffic violation or road accident.

- Its first wind power project Rojmal wind energy project 50 MW is being set up in Gujarat.
- 121. NTPC commissioned 2nd unit of 660 MW of Mouda Super Thermal Power Station Stagell (Maharashtra).
- 122. National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) developed world's first next generation atomic clock for deep space missions, to aid future manned deep space exploration missions by helping in navigation of space crafts.
- 123. National Commission for Schedule Tribes (NCST) approved five additional seats for tribals in Sikkim assembly (from 12 to 17 now).
- 124. National Conference on Innovation in Educational Administration organized in New Delhi by National University of Educational Planning and Administration (NUEPA).
- 125. National Green Tribunal (NGT) prohibited all camping activity within 100 meters along River Ganga from Shivpuri to Rishikesh in Uttarakhand, owing to Environmental and Pollution issues.
- 126. National Green Tribunal suspended environmental clearance for the Neutrino Observatory (INO) project to be set up in Tamil Nadu for research on high energy and nuclear physics, due to environmental concerns.
- 127. National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG) and Rotary India signed MoU for success of Namami Gange Programme.
- 128. National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority (NPPA) increased prices of stents (*tubeshaped device placed in the arteries that supply blood to the heart*) by 2%, keeping in view the wholesale price index.
- 129. National Safety Week (NSW) to observed from March 4 10, 2017 by National Safety Council (NSC) of India with theme *Keep Each Other Safe*
- 130. National Theatre Festival held at Thiruvananthapuram (Kerala).
- 131. National conference on Jal Kranti Abhiyan and an International Yoga fest held in New Delhi. International yoga festival was also organized in Rishikesh (Uttarakhand).
- 132. ONGC will invest over Rs 21,500 crore to develop India's deepest gas discovery by 202223, helping it more than double output from its prime KG basin block.
- 133. Odisha Government and Invest India signed agreement to promote startups and MSME sector of state, to help startups and MSME sector to gain access to best practices.
- 134. Odisha Government inaugurated a 24×7 toll free helpline number 181 for distressed women in Bhubaneswar.

- 135. Odisha signed agreement with State Bank of India to become first state to adopt Self Help Groups (SHG) based model for financial exclusion model to extend banking services in unbanked areas through SGHs (formed under Odisha Livelihood Mission).
- 136. On the occasion of 127th Foundation Day of National Archives of India (NAI), exhibition *Revolutionary Patriots* (19051947) been inaugurated.
- 137. PM Narendra Modi inaugurated India's longest cable stayed bridge in Bharuch (Gujarat). It is 1.4kilometer long fourlanes bridge over river Narmada and has been built by Larsen & Toubro.
- 138. PM Narendra Modi inaugurated Petro auditions Limited (OPal) in industrial town of Dahej in Gujarat as largest petrochemicals plant in Asia with occupation over 1700 metres of land. It will annually produce 14 lakh metric tonnes of polymers.0
- 139. Parliament passed Employees Compensation (Amendment) Bill 2016, amending Employee's Compensation Act 1923.
- It ensures compensation up to Rs 1 lakh to employee if an injured in an industrial accident.
- Employer will be penalised (50k 100k) if he fails to inform his employee of his right to compensation.
- 140. Parliament passed Maternity Benefits (Amendment) Bill 2016 (amending Maternity Benefit Act 1961) to raise maternity leave for working women from 12 weeks to 26 weeks for two surviving children. India will be in third position in terms of the number of weeks allowed for maternity leave in the world after Norway (44 weeks) and Canada (50).
- 141. Parliament passed Mental Healthcare Bill 2016, that decriminalises suicide attempt by mentally ill people and guarantees right to better healthcare for people with mental illness.
- 142. Parliamentary Committee under Bhagat Singh Koshyari suggested merger of telecom firms Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) and Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited (MTNL) for their longterm survival.
- 143. Pawan Hans launched Delhi Darshan rides with a 10minute sortie at Rs 2,499 per person.
- 144. Punjab Cabinet provided 33% reservation for women in all govt jobs.
- 145. Punjab and Jammu and Kashmir signed agreement for fasttrack completion of much delayed 206 megawatt (MW) Shahpur Kandi dam project on Ravi river.

- The new canyon system was probably formed by river Kandivalasa. It is very huge and its depth varies from about 90 2,500 metres.
- Last canyon systems off the Visakhapatnam coast were discovered in 1963 by American geologist E.C. LaFond of US Navy.
- 153. Solar Energy Scheme for Small Powerloom Units launched by government to provide financial assistance as capital subsidy to small powerloom units for installation of Solar Photo Voltaic (SPV) plants, to alleviate problem of power cuts, faced by decentralized powerloom units. Under this, plants have two options OnGrid Solar Power Plant (where power cuts and shortages are negligible and power tariff is high), OffGrid Solar Power Plant (in power shortage areas).
- 154. State Assembly Election Results 2017

- Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) became Largest Party with 312 Seats. It is a histortic win for any political party in Uttar Pradesh. Samajwadi Party got 47 seats.
- BJP got 39.7 % votes, while Bahujan Samaj Party got 22.2 %.
- Uttrakhand (70 Seats)
- With 57 Seats, Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) became Largest Party.

- BJP got 46.5 % votes, while Indian National Congress got 33.5 % votes.
- Goa (40 Seats)
- No clear Majority achieved by any party. Indian National Congress is leading party with 17 seats, BJP second with 13 seats. Although BJP got more percentage of votes than any other party.
- Manipur (60 Seats)
- No clear Majority achieved by any party. Indian National Congress is leading party with 28 seats, BJP second with 21 seats. Although BJP got more percentage of votes than any other party.
- Punjab (117 Seats) Indian National Congress won majority with 77 seats, Aam Aadmi Party second with 20 seats. INC got 38.5 % Votes.
- 155. Supreme Court banned sale of Bharat Stage (BS)III emission norm compliant vehicles from April 1, 2017, when environmentally friendly BSIV emission norms will come into force.
- 156. Tamil Nadu Government launched *Ammakalviyagam in* portal, as hub of learning, interaction and opportunities. It is dedicated to late Chief Minister Jayalalithaa.
- 157. Tamil Nadu Government launched women safety application called *Ammavin Aran*, meaning 'mother's fortress'. It will give details about nearest police station and hospital along with map and phone number.
- 158. Tata DAV School at Mithapur in Gujarat achieved Guinness World Record for the *Largest Tree Hug* programme, with participation of 1316 students and staff. Objective was to spread message of conservation of natural resources and need to nurture the environment.
- 159. Tata Motors signed MoU with Volkswagen Group and Skoda to explore strategic alliance opportunities for joint development of products.

- 2. Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) handed over naval systems to Indian Navy, to enhance navy's navigation and communication network
- USHUSII submarine sonar, Directing gear for hull-mounted sonar array, Inertial navigation system for ship applications.
- IP based secure phone Encryption algorithm on a trustworthy hardware platform, to provide high secrecy to voice and data.
- Gallium Nitride Technology It will Help in development of next generation radars and communication systems, for Light Combat Aircraft (LCA).
- 3. Hubble Space Telescope (HST) captured image of incredibly massive galaxy UGC 12591, approx 400 million light years away from Earth.
- 4. IBM researchers created world's smallest magnet using a single atom which can store one bit of data on it, as against current usage of approx 100,000 atoms by hard disks to store a single bit of data.
- IBM scientists used a scanning tunneling microscope (STM) to build isolated single atom bits using holmium atoms.
- This Invention can allow people and businesses to store 1,000 times more information in same space, making it very useful for future digital applications.
- 5. Indian Scientists discoverd 1.6 billion year old fossils containing red algae, that might well be oldest plantlike life discovered on Earth. It were dounf Chitrakoot region in Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh.

- 6. Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL), National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) are jointly working on the development of Dual Frequency (L and S band) Synthetic Aperture Radar Imaging Satellite named as NASAISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar (NISAR). The Lband SAR is being developed by JPL/NASA, While ISRo is developing S-band SAR.
- 7. Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) created commissioned world's third largest hypersonic wind tunnel at Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC) in Thiruvananthapuram (Kerala). ISRO commissioned two facilities 1m Hypersonic Wind Tunnel and a 1m Shock Tunnel.
- 8. Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has developed four types of lithium ion batteries for satellite and launch vehicle applications. These four types of batteries are 1.5Ah, 5Ah, 5OAh and 10OAh.
- 9. Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) joined 36th Indian Scientific Expedition to Antarctica (36 ISEA) organised by National Centre for Antarctic and Ocean Research (NCAOR). ISRO has sent 4 teams from Space Applications Centre (SAC), National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC), Indian Institute of Remote Sensing (IIRS) and Space Physics Laboratory(SPL). Objective is to install stakes on Differential Global Positioning System (DGPS) measurements around two Indian bases Bharati and Maitri in Antartica.
- 10. National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) announced its upcoming mission to explore Jupiter's mysterious moon *Europa* Europa Clipper.
- 11. Night parrot sighted for first time in last 100 years in Western Australia, which was thought to be extinct as of now.
- 12. Punjab Agricultural University Ludhiana claimed India's first genetically modified (GM) varieties of cotton PAU Bt 1 and F1861. Cotton is only genetically modified crop allowed to be cultivated in India. Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) also identified 3 Bt cotton varieties –F1861, PAU Bt 1 and RS2013 for cultivation in Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan.
- 13. Researchers from University of Glasgow (Scotland) developed prosthetic limbs with solar-powered skin, giving amputees a better sense capabilities of touch, temperature and texture compared to battery powered prosthetics.
- 14. Scientists at NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL) found India's first lunar probe, Chandrayaan1 as still orbiting the moon. ISRO lost communication with Chandrayaan1 on August 29, 2009, almost a year after it was launched on October 22, 2008.JPL also have found NASA's Lunar Reconnaissance Orbiter (LRO).
- 15. Scientists developed a tiny, ingestible 3Dprinted snakelike robot called SAW (single actuator wavelike robot), that can navigate through the small intestines. It can be used to visualise the digestive system in real time, especially for colonoscopies.
- 16. Scientists discovered oldest fossils on Earth in rocks from Quebec (Canada), dating approx 3.8 billion to 4.3 billion years old. Fossils are thought to be remains of bacteria that lived on iron and dwelt around Mineral rich hot springs on seafloor.
- 17. Scientists discovered polka dot tree frog (Hypsiboas punctatus), world's first fluorescent frog in Argentina. It sports a muted palette of greens, reds and yellows under normal light, but in dark gives off a bright blue and green glow.
- 18. Scientists from Eindhoven University of Technology (Netherlands) developed a new wireless Internet network based on infrared rays that is 100 times faster than existing WiFi (Wireless Fidelity) networks. It has capacity of over 40 Gigabits per second (Gbit/s).
- 19. Scientists from University of Cambridge (UK) created a structure resembling a mouse embryo, using two types of stem cells the body's master cells' and a 3D scaffold on which then can grow.
- 20. Scientists from the German Aerospace Centre developed world's largest artificial sun (Synlight) a device developed to help shed light on new ways of making climate friendly fuels, havong giant honey comblike setupm of 149 spotlights. Aim is to develop an optimal setup for concentrating natural sunlight to power a reaction to produce hydrogen fuel.
- 21. Scientists of University at Buffalo (USA) developed a solar-powered purifier, as an efficient and inexpensive way to turn contaminated water into potable water for personal use. Device is called *Solar Vapour Generator*.
- 22. Scientists using Large Hadron Collider accelerator (LHC) at CERN (European Organisation for Nuclear Research) discovered a new system of five particles, making This discovery unique by observing 5 new states all at once.
- These particle states are named Oc(3000)0, Oc(3050)0, Oc(3066)0, Oc(3090)0 b Oc(3119)0, with he numbers indicating masses in mega electronvolts (MeV).
- 23. USA Scientists have developed a blood test to predict whether a child has autism spectrum disorder (ASD), pavong way for earlier diagnosis and future development of therapeutics.
